The main emphasis of our work:

Giving advice and support to children and families This includes a wide range of offers concerning the care of children, the application of acknowledged methods for early diagnosis in general and the recommendation of advice centres and therapies if necessary.

Education of families and educational partnership Special offers that make it easier to cope with life and education are part of our field of interest, as well as activities with parents and their children. Language courses, offers for single parents and offers regarding health care are, in cooperation with other social institutions, an essential part of the Catholic Familiy Centre.

Taking care of children

In cooperation with a qualified educational institution, we are able to offer the training to become a child minder. By using a child minder you can choose the hours your children are being looked after according to your own needs.

Balancing family life and work

The care of children aged 2 to 6 years combined with the extensive opening hours of our day nursery (including looking after your children over lunch) make it easier for you to balance your professional and family life. After closing time you can make arrangements with a child minder if necessary.
